**DEAR 3JM PARENTS,**

It was another great week in 3JM. It is almost hard to believe that March is here already! The students in 3JM were extremely busy this week, even though the last two weeks have been short!

In **Language Arts**, students worked on writing chapters for their informational booklet. They are now experts on a topic and will be writing a book to teach the reader about it. We have also begun reading non fiction articles and students were asked to respond to the text with reactions and questions. We also used magazines to help us identify nonfiction conventions. Over the next few weeks, students will decide on the nonfiction conventions to use in their own books!

In **Math**, students continued to work on geometry. We focused on tessellations, symmetry, congruent figures, and 3d shapes. Students also made their own 3 dimensional polyhedron shapes by folding paper. The Unit 6 test will be on Wednesday March 6th.

In **Science**, the students read an article about chromatography (color writing). We also watched a video and the kids were able to see how real-life scientists use chromatography to identify substances.
