We had such a busy and productive week here in 3JM! I am really impressed by how the students have settled into the daily routines of third grade. I hope this superb effort continues:)

In math this week, we continued our study of unit 1 . We began by learning about the language of chance. Students discussed terms such as likely, unlikely, sure and not sure. Please ask your child to explain these terms to you at home. Students also practiced finding differences between numbers by using a number grid. We had so much fun using calculators to skip count and review place value. We will finish unit 1 next week and begin review for the unit 1 assessment which will be on Monday October 1st.

In writing, students continued to use strategies to gather ideas about a special place. We used the five senses to add descriptive details to out writing..

In reading students learnt how to find a just right book. They practiced using the 5 finger rule to decide if a book is at their level. Please ask your child to demonstrate this technique at
